


UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY


FALL 2005 - 2009 UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT DEGREE SEEKING


DEGREE SEEKING GRADUATES FALL 2005 - FALL 2009



LAW SCHOOL ENROLLMENT Full-time and Part-time 5-Year Trend


