### **THREE-THREE LAW/BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM**

After the approval of their academic advisors in consultation with the appropriate department chair, **freshmen pre-law students** with an acceptable ACT or SAT score may elect to enter the **Three-Three Law/Business Administration Program**. Ordinarily, a **26 ACT score or 1180 SAT score** will qualify a student for the program. Such students are expected to maintain at least a **3.25 GPA** in their undergraduate work to remain competitive for early admission to the Mississippi College Law School. Students in this program should plan to take the **LSAT as soon as possible after their sophomore year, but NO later than the fall of their junior year, as an acceptable LSAT score is required for admission to the Mississippi College Law School.** Acceptance into the **Three-Three Program, however, does NOT automatically guarantee admission to the Mississippi College Law School.**
