EDUCATION SPECIALIST (ED.S.)  
ADMISSION, MAINTENANCE AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Must have a Class AA Certificate in elementary education issued by a state department of education. A photocopy of the license is required.
2. Must meet all general requirements for admission to the graduate school of Mississippi College.
3. Must have a 3.25 grade point average on all prior graduate work.
4. Must supply 3 letters of recommendation from person familiar with the applicant's character, scholarship, and potential for successful completion of the program.
5. Must provide proof of three years of teaching experience.
6. Must schedule an entrance interview with the program advisor.
7. After 12 semester hours must maintain a 3.25 on all work in the Education Specialist program.
8. Must defend a research-based project completed during the Education Specialist program as an exit requirement.
