Field Experience Requirement:

• In addition to all course work listed above, the candidate will be required to complete <u>360 hours of Field Experiences</u> and submit corresponding verification forms for all field work.

Internship Experience Requirement:

• The candidate will complete <u>150 hours of focused Internship Experiences</u>. These hours will be part of the coursework for EDU 65361 & EDU 65362 during the enrolled semesters.

MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.Ed.) EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM OF STUDY

The previous list of course work and field experience hours is required for completion of the Master of Education in Educational Leadership from Mississippi College. Each candidate should determine which semester he/she will take each course in order to complete the required courses in a timely manner. Two options for completion exist: traditional or online. Included is an explanation of the Internship and Field Experiences required for successful completion of the program.

With the launch of the online delivery system, MC7, courses are taught in 7-week cycles. The MC7 course carousel has been constructed to allow candidates who are full-time (typically 2 classes) to complete their coursework in 12 months. For those students choosing part-time (typically 1 class), the program can be completed in 24 months.

MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.Ed.) EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP ADMISSION, MAINTENANCE AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. All General requirements for admission to Graduate School at Mississippi College must be met.
 - a. Graduate School Application for Admission is to be completed on-line.
 - b. A \$35.00 application fee (nonrefundable, must accompany application).
 - c. One copy of official transcripts mailed from the school or college directly to the Dean of Graduate Studies will be accepted.
- 2. Requirements for admission to a Master of Education Degree must be met.
- 3. Must maintain a GPA of 3.0 to remain in the program.
- 4. Standard educator's license and a minimum of 3 years teaching experience must be documented.
 - a. A photocopy of candidate's Standard Class Educators license issued by a state department for education. Candidate must hold a Standard, 5 year, renewable license to be considered.
- 5. Candidates will be notified in writing of the status of their application.
