Supplemental Endorsements for Education Majors

Completion of an approved MDE teacher-education degree program AND passage of the appropriate MDE prescribed licensure tests qualify the candidate to receive an initial Mississippi "A" licensure in their respective major. In order to **add a supplemental endorsement** in any area listed below to the initial Mississippi "A" educator license, the candidate must complete 21 semester hours of approved coursework in this specific content area earning a grade of "C" or better in each course.

*For the K-6 candidate, the following supplemental endorsement areas: English, General Science, Mathematics 7-8, or Social Studies, may be added to the initial Mississippi "A" educator license by completing two (2) areas of concentration consisting of 21 semester hours of coursework in each of the two (2) areas. In this case, some applicable Education (EDU) courses may be used in lieu of content area courses to meet the 21 semester hour requirement.
