- 1) Sixty-five hours applied towards graduation from Mississippi College must be earned at a senior college, regardless of the number of semester hours taken at the junior/community college level. This means that the maximum number of junior/community college semester hours that can be applied toward a degree at Mississippi College is 65. The last 33 semester hours must be taken at Mississippi College.
