The maximum number of junior/community college semester hours that can be applied toward a degree at Mississippi College is 65.

Admission requirements to enter the Social Work Program at MC:

Cumulative GPA = 2.5 or higher Completed program application form Three letters of reference Admissions interview with Social Work Admissions committee.

The admissions process for the Social Work program takes place during the Fall and Spring semesters.

Notes:

- 1) Sixty-five hours applied towards graduation from Mississippi College must be earned at a senior college, regardless of the number of semester hours taken at the junior/community college level. This means that the maximum number of junior/community college semester hours that can be applied toward a degree at Mississippi College is 65. The last 33 semester hours must be taken at Mississippi College.
- 2) Day students must take one to four semesters of Chapel. See Undergraduate Catalog for specifics.
- 3) Students must demonstrate proficiency in basic English grammar, usage, and writing skills by earning a passing score on the Writing Proficiency Exam.
