

## 10 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR A NATURALS AUDITION

1. Prepare three (3) songs of contrasting styles for the vocal audition. Choose the best 45 seconds to one minute of your best song to begin with. You may only get to sing portions of each of your songs.
2. A CD player and cassette player are available for you to use. An accompanist will also be there. Be sure and have the tape cued and printed music ready. If necessary.
3. Vocalization will take place after your song presentation. This will help us determine how you will fit into the choral ensemble.
4. Attire for the vocal audition should be dress casual. You want to make a good first impression.
5. Bring a change of clothes with you for the choreography portion of the audition. Shorts, t-shirts, or dance-style clothes are acceptable. Be sure to wear either dance shoes or sneakers.
6. There is no need to prepare a dance number. We want to see how quickly you learn.
7. These auditions are open to anyone who wishes to attend. Performing in front of an audience is helpful and will show the judges how you respond to an audience.
8. Be sure you have turned in your application or have it with you. A recent photograph should be attached. A 5x7 or larger is preferred.
9. Instrumentalists will need to play a prepared piece, sight-read, and play from a lead sheet.
10. Those wishing to be part of the crew will interview with the Crew Chief and should provide a resume listing experience in lighting or sound.
