**FACULTY INSTRUCTIONS  
FOR  
GRADUATE EXERCISES  
FRIDAY, MAY 11, 2007**

**IMPORTANT: There will be no rehearsal so please pay close attention to the instructions below.**

1. Time to line up: by 7:00 p.m.
2. The faculty will line up in Room 312 of Nelson Hall. You will march from 3<sup>rd</sup> floor to the Auditorium at 7:20 .m. You will be led by a faculty marshal.
3. Faculty will enter right center aisle (facing stage) and will ascend stairs on right back of stage. (NOTE: Graduates will enter left aisle (facing stage) and will be seated in the first seven rows in the center floor section.
4. Men will remove caps for prayer during the service. Tassels are worn on the left side if fastened to the edge of caps; otherwise, it does not matter.
5. The faculty will participate in the recessional. You will follow the stage party off the stage. The faculty marshal will lead you down the left center aisle (facing stage), and back to room 312 where you will turn in your regalia.
6. Dark clothes and dark shoes are suggested.
7. Please be prompt; we expect to start on time. You have always been cooperative and this is deeply appreciated.
