Reference for book with no author or editor:

Example: *Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary (10th ed.)*. (1993). Springfield, MA: Merriam-Webster.

- 1) Place the title in the author position
- 2) Alphabetize books with no author or editor by the first significant word in title (Merriam).
3. In text, use a few words of the title, or the whole title if it is short, in place of author. Citation: (Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary, 1993)

Reference for encyclopedia with author:

Example: Bergmann, P.G. (1993). Relativity. *The New Encyclopedia Britannica (Vol. 36, pp. 501-508)*. Chicago: Encyclopedia Britannica.

Reference for articles in Periodicals:

Example: Henry, W.A., III. (1990, April 9). Making the grade in today's schools. *Time*, 135, pp. 28-31.

Author, A.A., Author, B.B., and Author, C.C. (year published). Title of article. *Title of Periodical*, vol., pages.

Reference for books:

Example: Author, A.A. (year published). *Title of book: subtitle if one*. Location: publisher.

Reference for Online Periodical:

Example: Author. (date of publication). Title of article. *Title of Periodical*, vol. Retrieved month, day, year, from [http://www.....\(full URL\)](http://www.....(full URL))

Important you backspace to remove blue underlining and lettering.

Reference for book with two authors:

Example: Author, A.A. and Author B.B. (year published). *Title of book*. Location of publisher: Publisher's name.

Citation: (Author & Author, year of publication)

Reference for book with three or more authors:

Example: List them all up to six then add et al. in References.

Citation: (Author et al., year published) First author and et al., year published.

Reference for newspaper with author:

Example: Author, A.A. (year, month, day) Name of article. *Name of Newspaper*, pp. no.

Citation when two or more References are cited:

Citation: (Jones, 2000; Smith, 2001) Cite both with semicolon between.

Citation when authors have the same name:

Citation: (E. Jones, 2000; L. Jones, 2001) add their initial to differentiate.
