While Mississippi College *considers* English language scores from the above tests for admission purposes, <u>ALL</u> international students are required to pass the TOEFL-ITP administered at Mississippi College prior to enrolling in academic classes. The TOEFL-ITP requires proficiency in all areas demanded of non-English speakers; Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking.

Students who do not make acceptable scores on the Institutional English Evaluation Test will be required to enroll in the Intensive English Program at the evaluated level to insure academic success.
