## **College Level Examination Program (CLEP)**

The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) offers students the opportunity to obtain college credit by examination. Each college or university is individual and independent in setting CLEP policy. The student should check with the college or university where he/she is enrolled to learn about its CLEP requirements. If the score on the examination is acceptable to the institution where the student is enrolled, the student may receive credit. No quality points are awarded, only credit hours.

The student can mail or email the completed registration/admission form to Academic Computing at Mississippi College. Only one examination per person will be given on a single test date. The student will need to make out two checks: one to CLEP for \$80.00 and one to Mississippi College for a \$50.00 administration fee which is non-refundable. You can email the completed registration/admission form to <a href="mailto:sun@mc.edu">sun@mc.edu</a> and carry the checks when you take the test. If you want to mail the checks with registration form, please mail to: Academic Computing, Box 4050, Mississippi College, Clinton, MS 39058. A student may receive credit at Mississippi College for any of the following courses on which he/she achieves a satisfactory score, subject to the limitations listed below and if approved on the Credit by Examination form included in this information. Acceptable scores are subject to change when mean scores are updated by the College Board.

- 1. No student may receive credit toward graduation for more than 30 semester hours of work through CLEP, or through a combination of CLEP and other non-resident work.
- 2. CLEP credit in History will be limited to a total of six (6) semester hours chosen from the courses listed. To meet the six (6) hours of history CORE requirement, both courses must be from the same series, i.e. American History or World Civilization.
- 3. CLEP credit in English will be limited to a total of six (6) semester hours. A student may take only one literature course.
- 4. No student may receive degree credit by examination at a lower course level in a subject from which he/she has earned credit at an advanced level.
- 5. Mississippi College does not give credit for **General Examinations** nor does the College administer **General Examinations**.

## APPROVAL FOR MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE CREDIT BY CLEP EXAMINATION

The normal way to earn degree credit at Mississippi College is by taking college classes. However, Mississippi College does have several ways of validating prior learning or accepting credit from external sources. The maximum total of such credit in any combination is 30 semester hours. A student may receive credit toward graduation for a maximum of 30 semester hours of approved subject examinations through CLEP in approved subjects. ALL STUDENTS WISHING TO TAKE A CLEP EXAM FOR CREDIT AT MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE MUST GET PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE, LOCATED IN THE BASEMENT OF NELSON HALL.

Except under very special circumstances, all of a student's last 33 semester hours must be taken at Mississippi College in order to count toward a Mississippi College degree. CLEP examinations, which are designed to measure learning that took place before enrollment at Mississippi College, should be taken as early as possible. It may be possible to receive permission from the Vice President for Academic Affairs to earn CLEP credit for prior learning, even in the senior year, but a student must accept full responsibility for the risk of delayed graduation for failing to achieve the required score on the examination.
