CLINTON – Dan Yeary, pastor of the North Phoenix Baptist Church, will be the Evangelism lecturer at Mississippi College, February 2, 2004. The Evangelism Lecture will be held Monday evening, February 2, at 7:00 p.m. in the Grand Hall, second floor of the B.C. Rogers Student Center at Mississippi College. Admission for this event is free and the public is welcome to attend.

Yeary will also speak in chapel, in Swor Auditorium of Nelson Hall, Tuesday morning at 10:50 a.m. Again, the public is welcome to attend this event, free of charge.

Dr. Yeary received his B.A. from Hardin-Simmons University in Abilene, Texas in 1961 and his M.R.E. from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in 1965. He also received an honorary Doctor of Divinity from Hardin-Simmons in May 1996. He is the author of several publications including *Make Up Your Mind* and *Direct Access: The Priesthood of the Believer*.

Dr. Yeary has been the pastor of the North Phoenix Baptist Church since August 1, 1993. North Phoenix is one of the largest Southern Baptist churches in the nation with a membership that exceeds 20,000. Dan Yeary's key focus is on transitioning the church into the 21st century. Prior to coming to Phoenix he pastored in Coral Gables, Florida for eighteen years.

He is married to Melinda and they have three grown children and three grandchildren.
