MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE ANNOUNCES GUEST LECTURER AND NOTED SPEAKER, BAYLOR UNIVERSITY PROVOST, DAVID LYLE JEFFREY

Dr. David Lyle Jeffrey, Provost and Distinguished Professor of Literature and Humanities at Baylor University, will speak Tuesday, October 5, at 7 p.m. Anderson Hall, B.C. Rogers Center, on the Mississippi College campus. The public is invited to the lecture and there is no charge for admission.

Jeffrey will speak on "Engaging Faith and Knowledge." He is the general editor and co-author of *A Dictionary of Biblical Tradition in English Literature* (1992). Among other books are *The Early English Lyric and Franciscan Spirituality* (1975); *English Spirituality in the Age of Wesley* (1987); *English Spirituality in the Age of Wycliffe* (1988); and *People of the Book: Christian Identity and Literary Culture* (1996).

Dr. Jeffrey became Provost of Baylor University in 2003. He is a leading spokesman for the celebrated 2012 Initiative to secure Baylor's place as a world class Christian university
