WITHDRAWAL FROM UNIVERSITY

A student who desires to withdraw from school will need to contact the Bursar's office for the proper withdrawal procedure. It is necessary for the correct procedure to be followed, as dropping without official withdrawal earns a grade of F in each course.

Any claims for refunds of tuition will be based on the date on which the student files a request for honorable dismissal with the Bursar.

Financial aid recipients who withdraw or drop a course may not receive a refund as a result of the institutional tuition adjustment. Refunds will be credited to the respective programs (Perkins, FSEOG, SCHOLARSHIP, Stafford Loans and PELL) before any refund is made to the individual.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The courses registered for by course and section number are the courses for which grades will be posted. Students may drop and add courses on line through June 1, of the Summer A Term and afterwards must come to the Office of the Registrar to make changes to schedules, at which time a \$10.00 fee will be assessed against the student's account record. For Summer B Term, the last day to add/drop on-line is July 6, after which date students must come to the Office of the Registrar.

Other Fees:

Fees other than those outlined above are not refundable upon withdrawal.

Whenever it differs from the above, the University will comply with Public Law 102-325, Part G, Section 484B, of the Higher Education Amendments of 1992 for first-time students.

Refund/Repayment Policy Concerning Financial Aid:

If a refund is due a student under the school's refund policy and the student received any Title IV funds (other than Federal Work Study), a federally prescribed formula is used to determine the amounts that must be returned to each program involved.
