## For students who are undeclared, or UNDECIDED, in their major:

There are no "set" classes that a Freshman should take, but since students who are undecided concerning their major will have to take the core classes at some point, it is "safe" to go ahead and take core. Usually, a student will take an English course, a History course, a Bible course, etc. instead of trying to take all English, or all History, etc.

The following schedule represents what a "TYPICAL" undecided Freshman might take.

| ENG | 101 | English Composition | 3 hours |
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| BIB | 110 | Old Testament Survey (OR BIB 120: New Testament) | 3 hours |
| HIS | 103 | World History (OR HIS 211: US History) | 3 hours |
| GBU | 151 | Business Skills for Life* | 3 hours |
| ART | 125 | Art Appreciation (OR MUS 125: Music Appreciation, OR | 3 hours |
|  | $\quad$ THE 125 (Intro to Theater) |  |  |
| MAT | 105 | Contemporary Math (OR appropriate higher level math) | 3 hours |

*Or another core course.

Other core courses may be substituted. You may have AP credit, dual enrollment, or transfer hours that would change this "typical" schedule. You may be on a varsity sports team or in the choir and may need to adjust this schedule. The truth is that no one is typical, but this schedule is a good place to start. When you meet with your advisor to register, be sure to tell him/her about your specific set of circumstances so you end up with YOUR schedule and not just a typical schedule.

Chapel: Freshmen are required to take a total of 4 semesters of chapel.
