
NUMERICAL LEGEND



PARKING AT MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

LOCATION OF LOTS, DESCRIPTIONS, AND DIRECTIONS

ALL VEHICLES brought on campus by residence hall students, commuter students, faculty and staff **must be properly registered** with the Office of Public Safety located in Alumni Hall. **Temporary parking permits** are available <u>at no charge</u> through the Office of Public Safety 24 hours a day. Mississippi College <u>does not</u> assume responsibility for any losses of or damage to property that occurs in University buildings, lots or grounds.

- R1 LOTS: Restricted parking for University Place Residents and College Plaza.
- R2 LOTS: include (a) the lot directly behind Nelson Hall and on the west side of Hederman, Gunter, and Mary Nelson, (b) the lots on the south side of the Coliseum between Coliseum Drive and Capitol Street, (c) the Loop which begins south of Ratliff Drive and circles around West Tower and East Tower and up to the corner of McLemore Drive and Nelson Drive, (d) the lots directly south and east of the volleyball courts next to Whittington Hall and Quick Hall and (e) the lot south of Latimer Webb and north of Hwy. 80. R2 lots serve the women of Hederman, Gunter, Mary Nelson, Latimer Webb, East Tower, and West Tower. Overflow from R2 parking lots should go to the R2/R3 lots west of Coliseum Drive. (This does not include any parking spaces at the Healthplex.)
- R3 LOTS: include the areas (a) to the north of Cockroft/Caldwell~Hitt/McCullough Hall and (b) to the south and east of Whittington Hall. R3 lots provide parking for the residents of Cockroft/Caldwell~Hitt/McCullough Hall, Quick Hall, Whittington Hall, Chrestman Hall, and Ratliff Hall. Overflow from R3 parking lots should go to the R2/R3 lots west of Coliseum Drive. (This does not include any parking spaces at the Healthplex.)

R2/R3 LOTS: include parking lots west of Coliseum Drive and the 1st and 2nd floors of the parking garage.

COMMUTER STUDENTS (C Decals) are to park in parking lots designated as Lot 1, Lot 2, Lot 3, Lot 4, Lot 5, Lot 6, Lot 7 and all three floors of the parking garage. These lots are located around the following buildings (except where otherwise noted): Cockroft Hall, Hilltop Theater, the lots on the north side of Madison Street, the lot north of East Main Street and the lot north of the Physical Plant complex. Commuters may also park behind the First Baptist Church Family Life Building if that lot is not otherwise occupied.

Commuters and the Healthplex: Commuter students who are members of the Healthplex should obtain from the Healthplex Desk a Healthplex Parking Permit to be displayed on the front left dashboard of your vehicle **ONLY** when utilizing the Healthplex facility.

ADDITIONAL EVENING AND WEEKEND PARKING:

All lots north of College Street, 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., Monday through Thursday, are open to non-resident parking (Commuters and Faculty/Staff).

Faculty/Staff lots south of College Street, 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., Monday through Thursday, are considered open lots to resident and non-resident parking (Commuters and Faculty/Staff).

All Faculty/Staff lots (other than the Physical Plant lot), 3:00 p.m. Friday to 7:00 a.m. Monday, are considered open.

DESIGNATED PARKING places should not be violated at any time on weekdays, weekends or holidays. These spaces include the President, Vice Presidents, CFO and CIO spaces, Fire Zones, Handicapped and any space marked by signage or security cones.

VISITOR PARKING is designated by green curb paint and is reserved for guests of the University. Visitor parking is available in front of Nelson Hall. Resident students, commuter students, and Faculty/Staff are prohibited from parking in Visitor Parking at any time.

HEALTHPLEX PARKING is reserved for off-campus, Healthplex patrons. Resident students are strictly prohibited from parking at the Healthplex at any time. Commuters who are members of the Healthplex should obtain from the Healthplex Desk a Healthplex Parking Permit to be displayed on the front left dashboard of your vehicle ONLY when utilizing the Healthplex facility.

LOADING ZONES are designated and provide a temporary loading area. Vehicles should only use the loading zone areas to load or unload. <u>Time</u> restrictions are placed on these zones. If you have special loading/unloading needs, please contact The Office of Public Safety.

ADMISSIONS PARKING is located between Nelson Hall and B. C. Rogers Student Center. It is available for visitors to the Admissions Office. Resident students, commuter students, and Faculty/Staff are prohibited from parking in Admissions Parking from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

IMPROPERLY PARKED VEHICLES may be towed/relocated, at the discretion of the Office of Public Safety, from Loading Zones, Fire Zones, Handicapped Spaces, Reserved Parking Spaces, President, Vice President, CFO, CIO or other designated Tow-away Zones. A towing/relocation fee of will be charged. This fee will be the current rate established by the towing company. A tire lock may also be placed on improperly parked vehicles. A fee of \$50 will be charged to remove the tire lock.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE LAW SCHOOL students who live on campus must park in R-2 (women) or R-3 (men). Law School students are considered commuters when visiting the Clinton campus.

EMPLOYEES of Mississippi College should park in areas designated for Faculty/Staff and Physical Plant.

PARKING GARAGE levels 1 and 2 are designated All Park (Commuters, Resident, R2/R3). Level 3 is reserved for Faculty/Staff and Commuters.

FIRE ZONES are designated by red curb paint. To adhere to safety codes and for the protection of the campus population, NO PARKING WILL BE PERMITTED IN THESE AREAS.

HANDICAPPED SPACES are designated by blue curb paint. Only vehicles displaying a valid handicapped sticker issued by an appropriate state agency may park in these spaces.
