
#### **FULL-TIME INSTRUCTIONAL FACULTY**

Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) defines instructional faculty as faculty employed full-time whose major (more than 50%) regular assignment is instruction, including those with released time for research. This <u>includes</u> department chairs, but <u>excludes</u> deans and administrators who may have faculty rank. Before 1997 MC coded some individuals, who held a joint faculty/staff position as full-time faculty. (NOTE: This is in contrast with the definition of Faculty as defined by MC's Personnel Office on page 54.)

#### **FACULTY BY GENDER**





# **FACULTY IN EACH RANK**




