

ADMISSIONS PROFILE

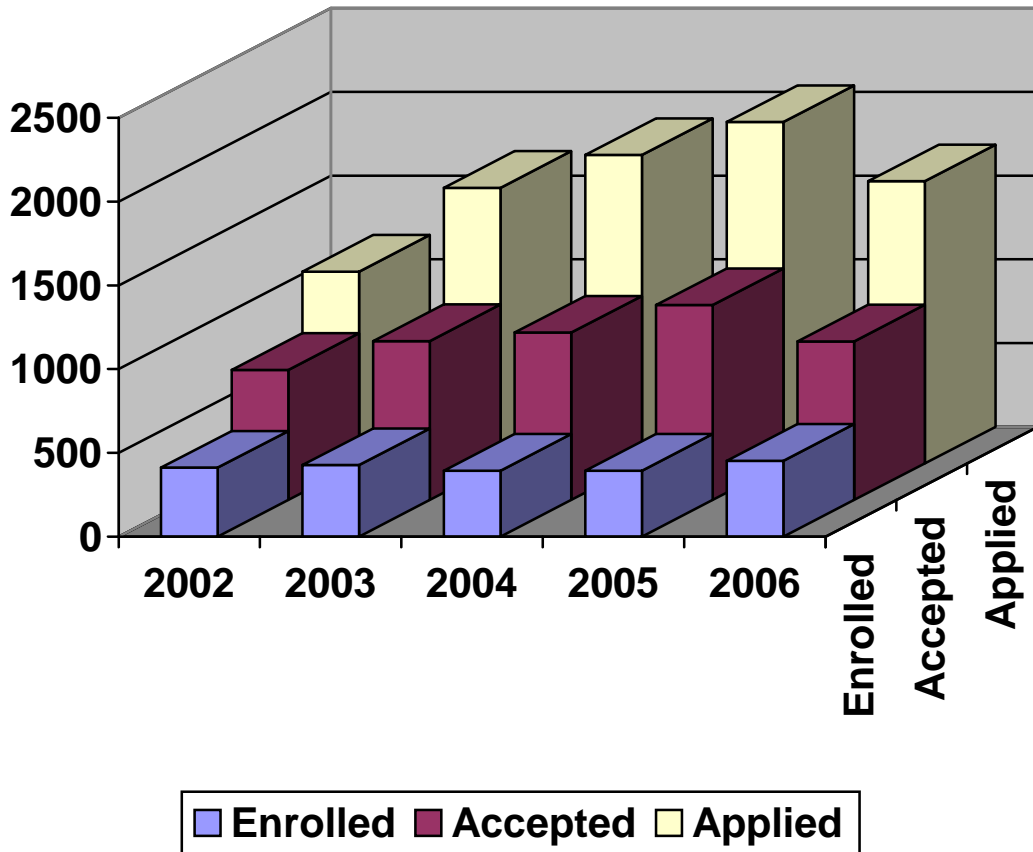
All admissions data are historical and include only those students who completed the semester with at least one credit hour.

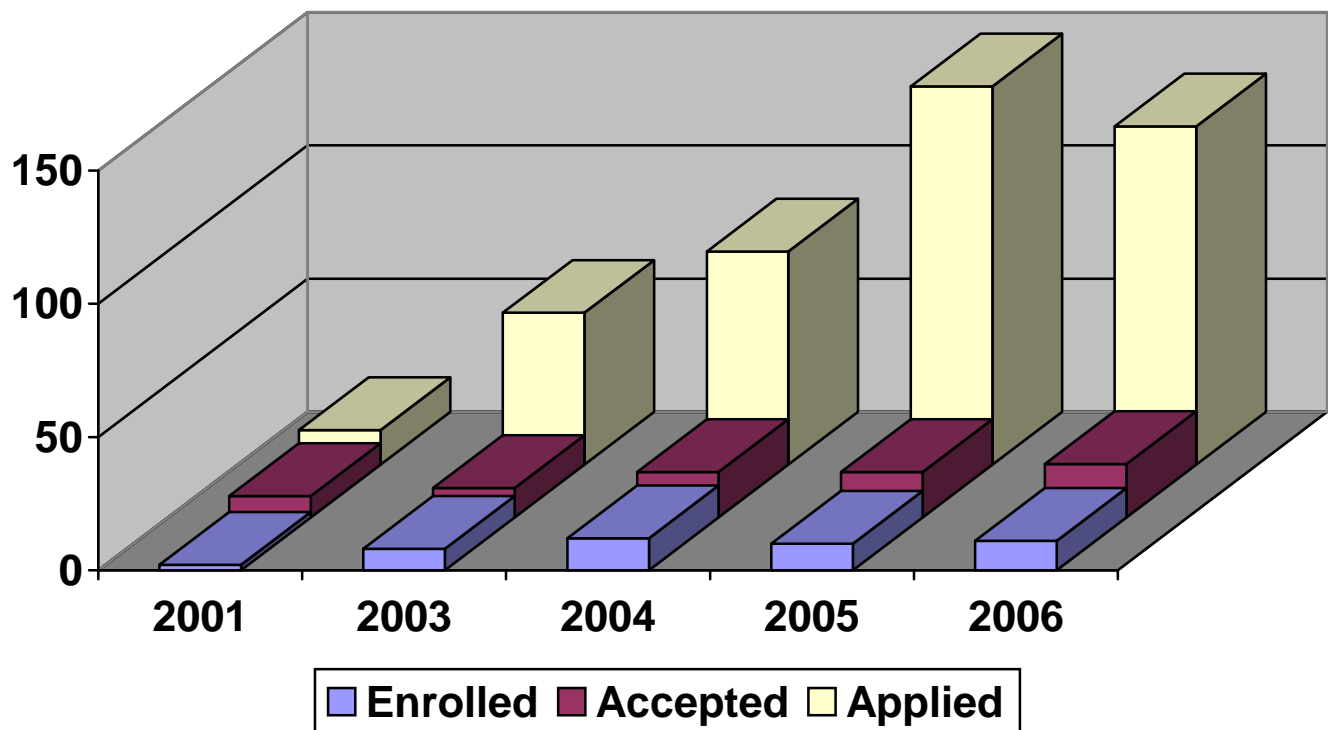


NON-TRADITIONAL FRESHMEN

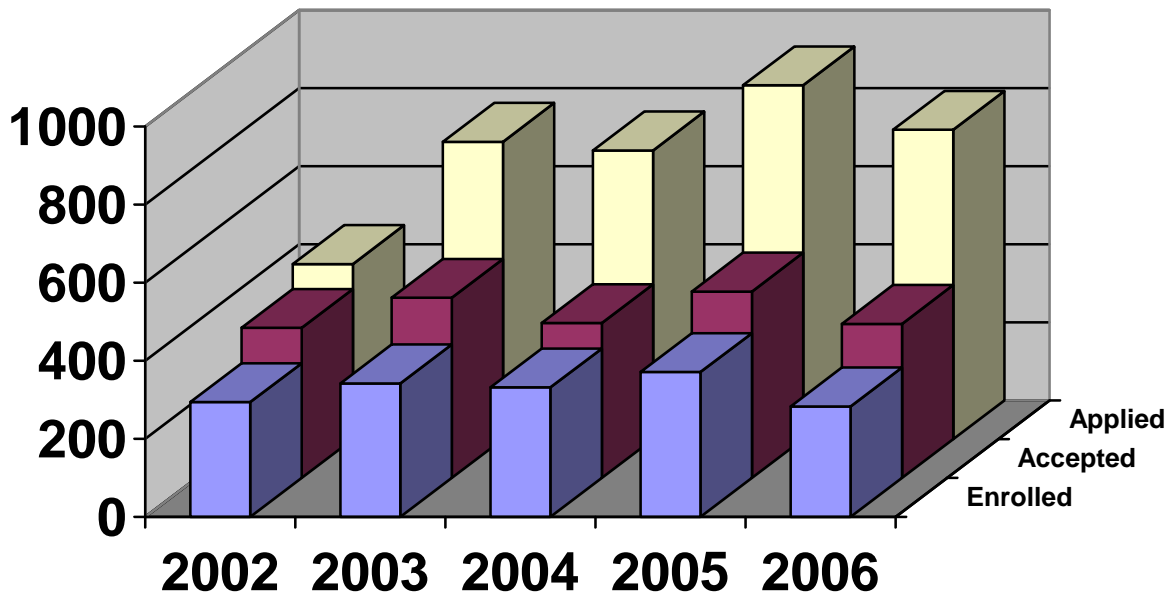

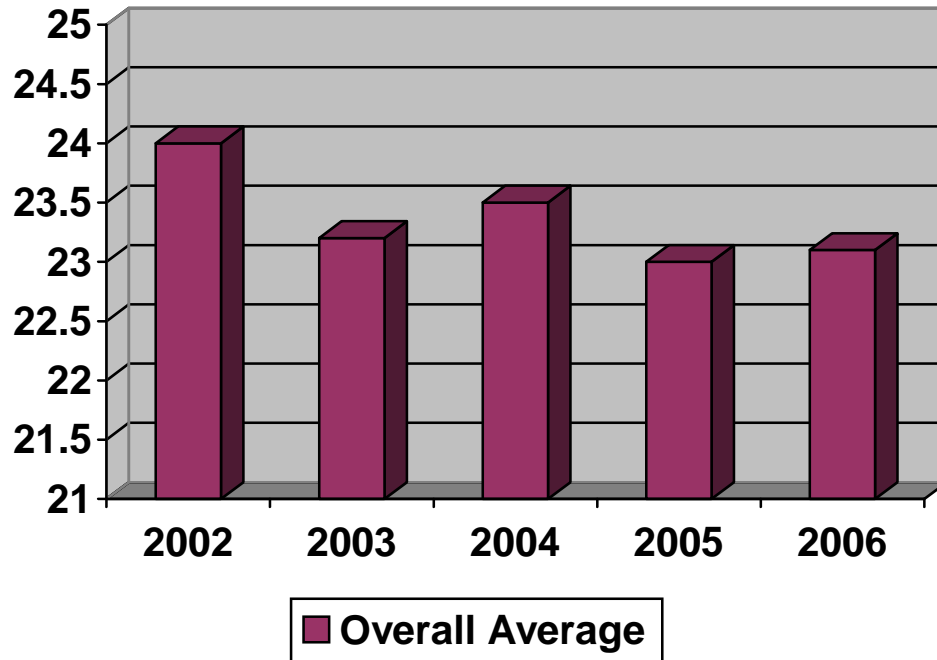
