


UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY


FALL 2003 - 2007 UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT DEGREE SEEKING


DEGREE SEEKING GRADUATES FALL 2003 - FALL 2007



LAW SCHOOL ENROLLMENT Full-time and Part-time 5-Year Trend


