

HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY OF BUILDINGS AS OF 2009-2010

BUILDING	ACCESSIBILITY
Alumni Hall – Built 1926	Made curb cut and raised sidewalk to front entrance to provide accessibility in 1993. Installed handicapped accessible steps in swimming pool.
Aven Hall – Built 1959	Installed curb cut, ramp, outside door and designated parking in 1992. Installed elevator with ADA handicap requirements in 1992.
Band Hall	Building entry ins accessible as built.
B.C. Rogers – Built 1960	Installed curb cut and designated parking. Installed elevator with ADA Handicap requirements in 1986. Provided accessible toilet facilities in 1993.
Cockroft – Built 1976	Building surveyed to assure that entry into building can be made by handicapped persons. Back doors into both Home Economics and Nursing are wheelchair accessible. Women's room in School of Nursing is handicapped accessible as built. On 1-7-09, a handicapped accessible ramp was constructed to provide a new entrance to the Department of Kinesiology. This was performed due to the reassignment of the space that was used originally for ADA access.
Coliseum – Built 1977	Building entry is accessible on both levels as built. Building has accessible door hardware as built. Building has accessible toilet facilities as built.
Farr Hall – Built 1926	Building was renovated in 1998 and brought up to ADA standards. On 10-22-2007, a handicapped accessible ramp was constructed to provide a new entrance in to the upper area of Farr Hall.
Hederman Science – Built 1967	Building entry is accessible on lower level as built. Handicapped parking designated adjacent to building in 1978.
Jennings – Built 1907, Renovated in 1995	Installed curb cut, ramp, accessible outside door and designated parking. Installed elevator with ADA handicap requirements. Installed accessible door hardware. Provided accessible restroom facilities. Installed accessible water fountains. Lowered telephones.
Jennings Annex – Built 1908, Renovated 1995	Installed curb cut, ramp, accessible outside door and designated parking. Installed accessible door hardware. Provided accessible restroom facilities. Installed accessible water fountains.
Law School – Built 1954, Renovated 1979, Additions Built 1979 & 2004	Installed curb cut, ramp, accessible outside door and designated parking. Installed additional elevator to provide access to library as well as classroom areas. Modified rest rooms to provide handicapped accessibility.
Law School Student Center – Built 2005	Accessible as built
Library – Built 1959, Addition Built 1974	Installed curb cut, ramp, accessible outside door and designated parking in 1978. Modified elevator to meet ADA Handicap requirements in 1992.
Lowrey – Built 1914, Addition Built 1960	Installed curb cut, ramp, accessible outside door and designated parking in 1990. Installed an elevator that meets ADA handicap requirements in 1994.
Nelson Hall – built 1948	Installed curb cut, ramp accessible outside door and designated parking in 1992. Installed an elevator that meets ADA handicap requirements in 1992. Installed windows in Business Office that are handicapped accessible in 1994. Provided accessible restroom facilities in 1996. Installed flashing alarm systems in 1996. Lowered telephones.

Provine Chapel – Built 1860	Installed curb cut and designated accessible parking spaces. Accessible outside door to first floor is available as built.

Robinson Hale Stadium – Built 1985	Installed curb cut and designated parking. Provided accessible restroom facilities.
Moody Adams Field House – Built 1982	Installed curb cut and designated parking. Provided accessible restroom facilities.
Self Hall – Built 1964	Installed curb cut and designated accessible parking spaces. Accessible outside door to basement floor is available. Built ramp to provide accessibility to first floor. Build ramp on sidewalk from Hederman Science to provide accessibility from there to basement of Self Hall.
Residence halls	Mary Nelson bathrooms were renovated to meet ADA standards in 1995. New Men's Dorm was completed in 1997. Mary Nelson, Latimer Webb and Whittington were refurbished in 1996. Refurbishing included the following: Renovated bathroom facilities in Latimer Webb and Whittington to meet ADA requirements Installed accessible door hardware in Whittington and Mary Nelson Lowered telephones New Women's Residence Hall East and West Towers was completed Summer 1999. East Tower was designed to accommodate twelve (12) physically handicapped students. Both Towers have handicapped accessible entrances that meet ADA requirements.
Math, Chemistry & Computing Science MCC Connector Building	Was completed in the Summer of 1999. All outside entrances are handicapped accessible and meet ADA requirements. Because MCC connects to all floors of Hederman Science and Self Hall, these buildings now meet ADA requirements on accessibility.

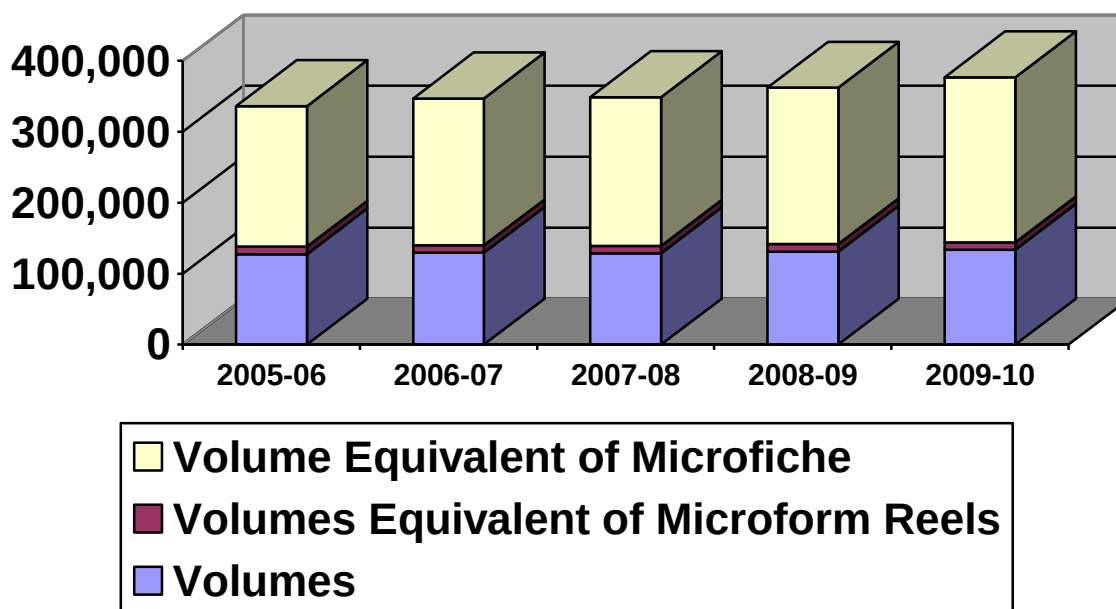
