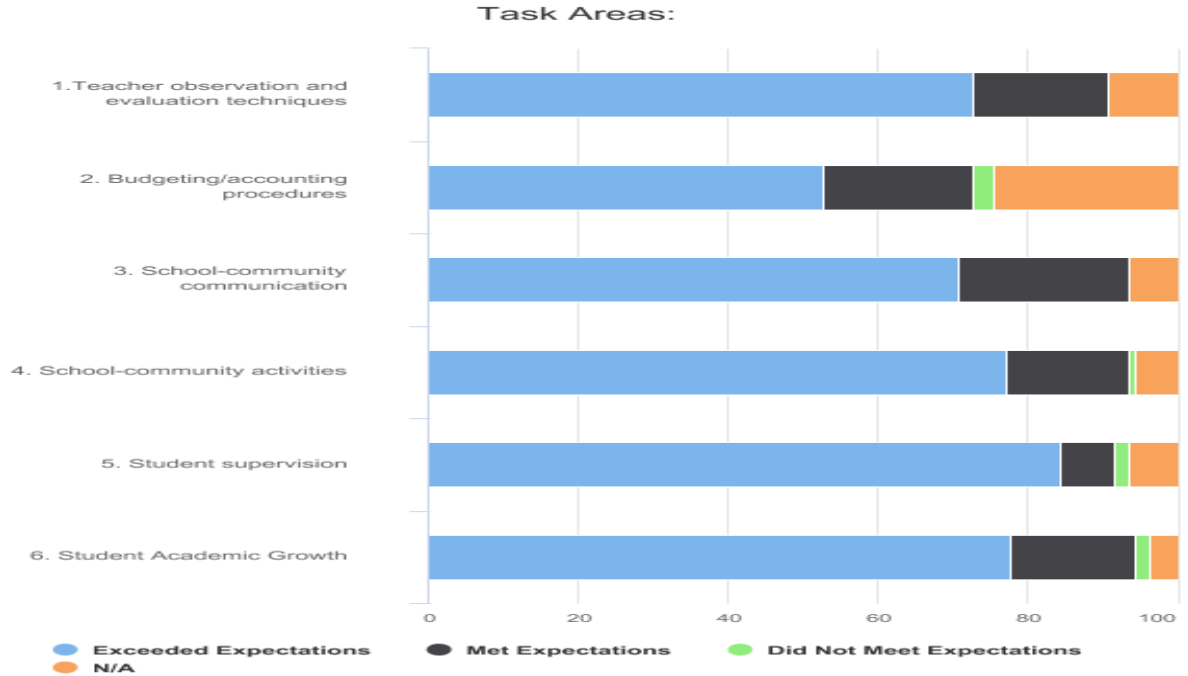


**Satisfaction of Employers—Advanced Programs
