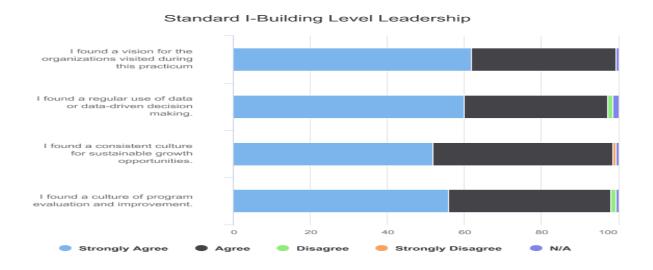
Satisfaction of Completers—Advanced Programs Educational Leadership 2017-2018

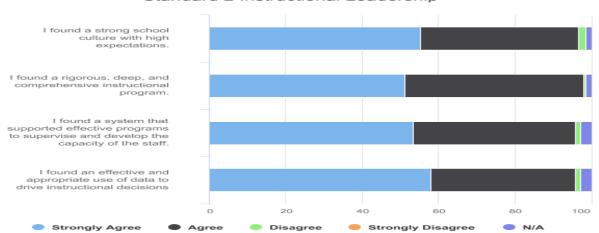

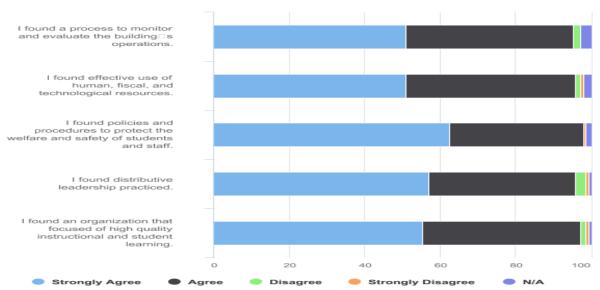

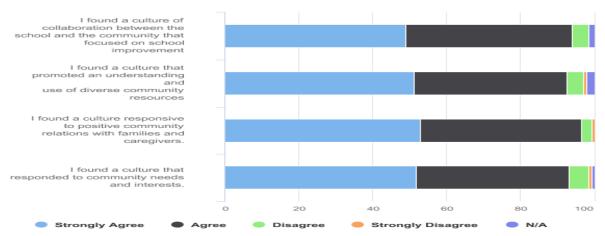

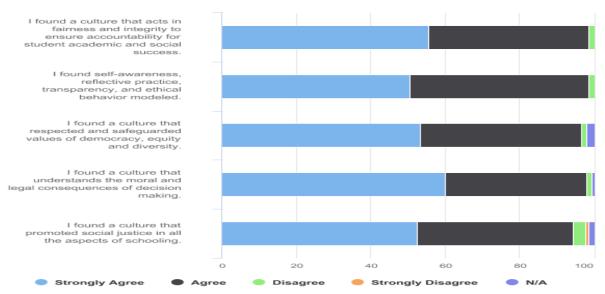
