Students considering an entry-level course in Mathematics at MC should consider the following guidelines:

## MATH ACT below 16

- MAT 100 - College Algebra Basics
- MAT 111 - College Algebra with Applications, only provided that the student has grades of B or better in high school Algebra I and II


## MATH ACT between 16 and 20

- MAT 105 - Contemporary Mathematics (preferred), or
- MAT 111 - College Algebra with Applications


## MATH ACT between 21 and 25

These students should not take College Algebra unless the major department requires the course.

- MAT 113 - College Trigonometry - (Sciences or proceeding to Calculus I)
- MAT 205 - Finite Mathematics - (Business/Social Sciences)
- MAT 207 - Elementary Statistics - (Anyone)
- MAT 213 - Applied Linear Algebra - (Sciences or Business)


## MAT ACT 25 or higher

- MAT 121 - Calculus I with Analytic Geometry

Additionally, students who have already taken trigonometry, pre-calculus or calculus in high school and received a grade of C or better could be advised to register for MAT 121 at Mississippi College.
