	8 pts - <u>Historical</u>	200 words minimum History of artist, history about the artwork
	8 pts - <u>Descriptive</u>	200 words minimum Full description of artwork, subject matter, elements and principles of art
	8 pts - <u>Analytical</u>	200 words minimum How the work is composed, principles of art, media, quality, techniques, how put together, uniqueness, comparison to other similar works.
	8 pts - <u>Interpretative</u>	150 words minimum Meaning or purpose, allegory, iconology, or metaphor, feelings expressed, statement, meaning, mood, point of view, message, your interpretation.
	8 pts - <u>Judgment</u>	100 words minimum Conclusion about success or failure of work, intelligent evaluation, craftsmanship or quality, uniqueness, value to you and art world, personal response to work, support with good reasons.
	10 pts. - Correct number of words	Correct font, correct writing, correct content Correct citations*
10 points	Picture Page –	Arranged correctly (portrait, with at least 1” margins) Labeled (artist, period, title, medium, size, location) Citation (source of picture, source of information)
30 points	References -	Correct form, correct font, correct information Written correctly References used correctly – citations in paper* Three different kinds of references – book, magazine, Internet, Abstracts, Journal, letter, brochures, encyclopedia, film or video or recordings, manuscript, newspaper, personal communication (interviews), theses or papers, other.
