Key Responsibilities

- Coordinate and oversee freshman biology laboratories, including:
 - Developing and updating laboratory curricula
 - Preparing and setting up laboratory materials and equipment
 - Supervising and mentoring student workers and adjunct laboratory instructors
 - Teaching two to three freshman biology lab sections
- Create and administer common midterm and final laboratory examinations for all freshman biology lab sections
- Teach Anatomy and Physiology I and II, including oversight of the accompanying laboratory sections
- Ensure consistency and quality across all assigned laboratory sections
- Participate in departmental meetings, curriculum development, and assessment activities

Qualifications

- **Required:**
 - Master of Science (MS) in Biology
 - Ability to effectively teach undergraduate biology and laboratory courses
- **Preferred:**
 - Experience teaching freshman biology laboratories
 - Experience teaching Anatomy and Physiology I and II
 - Experience coordinating laboratory programs or supervising instructional staff
