- Develop and revise course syllabi in alignment with program learning outcomes and accreditation standards.
- Deliver instruction using effective pedagogical practices appropriate for undergraduate and graduate education.
- Provide academic advising and mentorship to students.
- Participate in assessment of student learning and program effectiveness.
