October 3, 2016

- The regular weekly meeting of the Mississippi College Student Senate was held Monday, October 3, 2016 at 9:18 p.m. Student Senate President West presided over the meeting and Senate Clerk McRae was present. Invocation was given by Senator Channell. Pledges were given by Senator Castle. Senators K. Collins and Gaddy were absent. Senators Glass, Hicks, Lagarde, Powell and K. Smith were counted tardy. The minutes were approved as corrected. Motion to previous question was given by Senator Stringer.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-02 asking that Mississippi College Student Senate stand in unity with the Southern Baptist Convention and temporarily replace the current state flag was reiterated by Senator Rodriguez. Motion to debate was given by Senator Stringer. Senators Barlow, Rodriguez, Damon and Ladner spoke in affirmation. Senators Stringer, Pike and J. Richardson spoke in negation. Motion to roll call vote was given by Senator Rodriguez. Senate Resolution 2016-17-02 passed 22-13-0.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-03 asking for repair work to be done in the Prayer Garden was reiterated by Senator J. Richardson. Motion to amend the bill on the grounds of an error in grammar was made by Senator Nash. Motion to skip debate and voice vote was given by Senator Stringer. The ayes had it and Senate Resolution 2016-17-03 passed.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-04 asking for notification on parking tickets was reiterated by Senator Shamblin. Motion to amend the bill was made by Senator Stringer. The motion to voice vote on the amendment was made by J. Richardson. The ayes had it and the amendment for Senate Resolution 2016-17-04 passed. Motion to skip debate and voice vote on the bill was made by Senator Castle. The ayes had it and Senate Resolution 2016-17-04 passed.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-05 regarding renovations in Ratliff bathrooms was presented by Senator Rodriguez.
