Invocation was given by Senator Channell. Pledges were given by Senator Castle. Senators Barlow, Collins and Stringer were absent. Senators Denley and G. Smith were counted tardy. The minutes were approved as corrected. Motion to previous question was given by Senator J. Richardson.
- The freshman class officers presented their 2016-2017 Class Plan of Action. A motion to skip debate and voice vote was given by Senator Hicks. The ayes had it and the Freshman Plan of Action passed.
- The 2016-2017 SGA budget was presented by SGA Treasurer McCarty. The motion to approve the budget by voice vote was given by Senator B. Richardson. The ayes had it and the SGA budget was approved.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-01 asking that power outlets be installed at the Piazza was reiterated by Senator J. Richardson.
 The motion to skip debate and voice vote was given by Senator Hicks. The ayes had it and Senate Resolution 2016-17-01 passed.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-02 asking that Mississippi College Student Senate stand in unity with the Southern Baptist Convention and temporarily replace the current state flag was presented by Senator Rodriguez. The motion to amend the bill was made by Senator B. Richardson. Motion to open the floor to debate was made by Senator Castle. Senator Channell spoke in affirmation. No Senators spoke in negation. Motion to roll call vote on the amendment was made by Senator Hicks. Amendment to Senate Resolution 2016-17-02 passed 37-0-0.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-03 asking for repair work to be done in the Prayer Garden was presented by Senator J. Richardson.
- Senate Resolution 2016-17-04 asking for notification on parking tickets was presented by Senator Shamblin.
- Student Senate President West reminded new Senators to attend the training night on Monday, October 3.
