



**For students who are Electrical Engineering majors:**

The Electrical Engineering Department suggests freshmen take the following courses. Lecture courses with lab components are co-requisites and must be registered at the same time.

The following schedule represents a “**TYPICAL**” first-semester Freshman schedule for EE:

ECE	101	Introduction to Electrical Engineering	2 hours
CHE	141	General Chemistry I Lecture AND Lab	4 hours
MAT	121	Calculus with Analytical Geometry	3 hours
ENG	101	English Composition I	3 hours
BIB	110	Old Testament ( <b>OR</b> BIB 120: New Testament)*	3 hours
ART	125	Art Appreciation ( <b>OR</b> MUS 125: Music Appreciation <b>OR</b> THE 125: Intro to Theater)*	<u>3 hours</u>
			18 hours

\* OR choose another Core course.

You may have AP credit, dual enrollment, or transfer hours that would change this “typical” schedule. You may be on a varsity sports team or in the choir and may need to adjust this schedule. The truth is that no one is typical, but this schedule is a good place to start. When you meet with your advisor to register, be sure to tell him/her about your specific set of circumstances so you end up with YOUR schedule and not just a typical schedule.

**Chapel:** Freshmen are required to take a total of 4 semesters of chapel. Freshmen are automatically enrolled in Freshman Chapel/Blue & Gold 101 for their first Fall semester.
