



For students who are ART majors:

The Art Department has a set of core classes that all Art majors must take, regardless of the specific area of Art they decide to focus on. Several of these courses are prerequisites to sophomore level classes, so need to be taken before the second year.

The following schedule represents what a first semester **"TYPICAL"** Art major might take.

ENG	101	English Composition	3 hours
BIB	110	Old Testament (OR BIB 120: New Testament)	3 hour
SOC	205	Intro to Global Context*	3 hours
ART	101	Basic Design I	3 hours
ART	205	Intro to Graphics Software	<u>3 hours</u>

You may have AP credit, dual enrollment, or transfer hours that would change this "typical" schedule. You may be on a varsity sports team or in the choir and may need to adjust this schedule. The truth is that no one is typical, but this schedule is a good place to start. When you meet with your advisor to register, be sure to tell him/her about your specific set of circumstances so you end up with YOUR schedule and not just a typical schedule.
