For each statement below, use the sources mentioned to determine if the information is true or false. **If the statement is false, use the source to correct the statement.**

1. Go to the library home page at <http://library.mc.edu> and select the Ask-A-Librarian service. Here you can access frequently asked questions 24/7 and you can question or text a librarian during the hours the library is open. Use this service to verify the information below:

Mississippi College was one of approximately 131 institutions chosen to administer a Navy officer training program during World War II. A Navy V-12 unit was begun on campus in 1943, with the Navy men attending regular classes and participating in extracurricular activities. These men were also active in campus government, and served as the president of the student body, the vice president, and the student attorney. Eventually, approximately 902 students were enrolled in the program at MC.

In the Databases list, scroll down and select Regional Business News. Find an article about Sam Gore, a Mississippi artist who teaches at Mississippi College. Name two of his sculptures and their location.
3. Go to the Library Facebook page at <http://www.facebook.com/libraryMC>. “Like Us” in order to get timely updates about library events. Read the entry for Blue & Gold - MC History to determine if the following information is true or false.

Built in 1859-1860, Provine Chapel is the oldest building on the MC campus. According to local history, Confederate troops used the ground floor of the facility to quarter the horses, while wounded soldiers were treated in the "hospital" upstairs. In a skirmish on the campus in 1864, Confederate troops were firing from the upper floor of the Chapel. True or False
